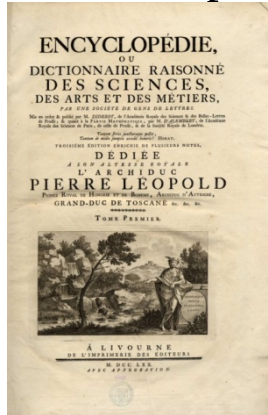


FRENCH FOR READING

Students will study the basic structures of French grammar and complete translation homework at an accelerated pace using a textbook designed for intensive acquisition of reading skills with, necessarily, no attention to oral proficiency. You will also have practical training as you translate a research article in your discipline, chosen by yourself, with the professor's approval.
