A GEN.ED. EXIT REQUIREMENT COURSE TAUGHT IN ENGLISH

**By Distinguished University Professor Dr. Gaëtan Brulotte**

Romantic and passionate love is not a natural given of the human condition. It is a cultural phenomenon that has been created in the early stages of civilization and has become a universal concern of mankind. The course will focus on the substantial French contribution to the evolution of romantic and passionate love. It will trace the history of this major cultural dimension from the early Middle Ages to present. From a courtly art in the medieval times, love was transformed through legendary figures of seduction such as Don Juan or Casanova and reshaped as it was confronted to the "Age of Reason" during the 18<sup>th</sup> c. when it gave birth to "libertinism", before becoming a quest for the absolute and a devastating passion during the 19<sup>th</sup> c., a stroke of luck and a pure wonder at the turn of the 20<sup>th</sup> c., and the only positive intimate and anti-racist value left to the human condition at the beginning of the 21st c.

Get to know the most famous love stories that have inspired literary masterpieces and fairy tales as well as great artists, folk songs and crafts, musicians and filmmakers. Get familiarized with major issues related to love and get to understand how this powerful feeling created enduring myths that were among the great seminal ideas of the Western world.
