

# GER 3501– Urban Life & Culture in Germany

GER2201 is a three-credit language and culture course taught in German; the “working language” of the course is German (students & instructors). This course will explore the most important cities located in Germany, such as Berlin, Munich, Cologne, and Hamburg with an emphasis on contemporary urban life and culture in Germany, but it will also draw on some historical background. Students will watch videos, read texts, and explore internet sites detailing the uniqueness



of each city. “Urban Life & Culture” is designed for students with low-intermediate and mid-intermediate competencies in German (A2-B2 [\[CEFR\]](#) range). The course will focus on improving students’ speaking, reading, and listening skills as well as reinforce and expand upon grammar topics
