

## RUS1120 BEGINNING RUSSIAN I



This is the first course in a two-semester sequence designed to develop the basic language skills in listening comprehension, reading, conversation, and writing. The course also introduces the fundamentals of Russian grammar and familiarizes students with the most important socio-cultural information.

Students will learn about 600 words (including various forms) required to perform successfully in reading, writing, listening, and conversation on the assigned topics (survival level). Students would be able to understand the most specific aspects of Russian language communication, addressing common misunderstanding / misinterpretation by non-native speakers.

Classes are very interactive. Grading is based on class participation, homework, quizzes, tests and interview. We have a lot of extra credit for participation in extra curriculum activities.
